**Title:** Permission to Enter an Inter-Local Agreement with the City of Toledo for the Purpose of Applying for the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Grant Funding through the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council

**Summary/Background:** The CESF Program provides funding to assist eligible states, local units of government, and tribes in preventing, preparing for, and responding to the coronavirus. The intergovernmental agreement is a requirement due to The City of Toledo and Lucas County applying jointly through CJCC.

**Budget Impact:** Total Grant \$58,008.00 - No Budget impact, No match required

**Statutory Authority/ORC:** 307.92

**Commissioner Byers offered the following resolution:**

WHEREAS, in consideration of the above, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lucas County that:

Section 1. This Board hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Toledo for the purpose of submitting a joint application for the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Grant through the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council.


Section 2. The Board hereby authorizes the President of the Board to sign the agreement on behalf of the Board.

Know All By These Present

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF TOLEDO, OHIO AND COUNTY OF LUCAS, OHIO**

**2020 Corona Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program**

This Agreement is made and entered this 11th day of May between the COUNTY of Lucas, acting by and through its governing body, the Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the CITY of Toledo, acting by and through its governing body, the Toledo City Council, hereinafter referred to as CITY, both of Lucas County, State of Ohio, witnesseth:

**WHEREAS**, Lucas County and the City of Toledo, have identified a need for a coordinated effort on the part of all City and County agencies involved in the criminal justice system and have jointly created the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, herein after referred to as CJCC, pursuant to Chapter 181, O.R.C., and through City Ordinances #866-71, #100-86 and #506-94 and County Resolutions #223-72, #86-141 and #94-1313: and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, finds the community's interest best served by appointing the CJCC to serve as administrative agent over performance of those payments from current revenues legally available to both parties: and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services of functions under this Agreement: and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and COUNTY agree to submit a joint application for CESF. The City of Toledo has been allocated \$951,152 and Lucas County has been allocated \$58,008. The total CESF application to be submitted is \$1,009,160. and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and COUNTY believe it is in their best interests to have CJCC coordinate the administration of the CESF funds.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the CITY and the COUNTY agree as follows:

**Section 1.**

CITY designates its allocation to the CJCC for developing a coordinated City of Toledo funding plan. CITY funding (\$951,152) will be used for Toledo Police Department and Toledo Municipal Court address COVID-19 related challenges.

**Section 2.**

COUNTY designates its allocation to the CJCC for developing a coordinated Lucas County funding plan. COUNTY funding (\$58,008) will be used for Lucas County Sheriff's Office to address COVID-19 related challenges

**Section 3.**

CJCC agrees to apply for and receive the combined designation of CESF funds on behalf of CITY and COUNTY. The CJCC further agrees to administer CESF funds on behalf of CITY and COUNTY for the combined allocation of \$1,009,160.00.

**Section 3.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed under applicable law.

**Section 4.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed under applicable law.

**Section 5.**

Each party to this Agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

**Section 6.**


This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of Lucas County, State of Ohio, of the United States. The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any additional party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.


**Section 7.**




