## ARRESTEES (CALENDAR YEAR 2007)...

- 5,523 arrests:
  - Average bookings daily = 15.1
  - Average Daily Population = 185
- Offenses booked \*:
  - 85% misdemeanor
  - 15% felony
- Arrestee Demographics \*:
  - 77% male; 23% female
  - 72% white
  - 19% black
  - 6% American Indian
- Average stay = 13 days, up from 7 days in 2002
- Arrests from 2003 to 2007
  - Disorderly Conduct ↑ 79%
  - Weapons Violations ↑ 68%
  - Credit/ATM Fraud ↑ 65%
  - Robbery ↑ 58%
  - Motor Vehicle Theft ↑ 58%
  - Drug Violations ↑ 57%
  - Forgery ↑ 51%
  - Stalking/Criminal Threat ↑ 67%
  - Bad Checks ↓ 244%
  - Burglary ↓ 83%
  - Arson ↓ 50%
