

<u>Communication Between Agencies</u> – The Community Partners recognize that each agency have different guidelines regarding the sharing of information. The partners have agreed to share information in the following ways:

- 1. A release of information listing community agencies will be developed for the ease of sharing client information.
- 2. Some agencies will continue utilizing the current release of information developed by the agency for the purpose of sharing information.
- 3. A list will be compiled that will include each agency's contact person and contact information for the use of the TJC Community Partners.
- 4. Each partnering agency will release the information to the requesting agency within one week of the request.
  - a. If this is not possible, the agency with the records will contact the requesting agency and give a timeline for release.

<u>Responsibility of Each Community Partner</u> – To the best of each agency's ability, each community partner agrees to the following:

- 1. Attend TJC Initiative Meetings as scheduled.
- 2. Support the goals and mission of the TJC Initiative and develop and understanding of jail reentry.
- 3. Have a willingness to work with the correctional population, inside and outside the jail.
- 4. Received correctional client referrals.
- 5. Collect and share required data.
- 6. Represent the mission and goals of the TJC Initiative in the home agency.
