



According to 42 CFR 2.35(a) persons or agencies "may disclose to persons within the criminal justice system which have made participation in program a condition of the disposition of any criminal proceedings." Further disclosure of this information is prohibited, except with the specific written consent of the person to whom it pertains and only to those individuals within the criminal justice system who have a need for the information in connection with their duty to monitor the offender's progress and who have made participation in program a condition of the disposition of any criminal proceedings for the purpose of coordinating inmate care.
